

Mark your calendar! October 14<sup>th</sup>, 10:15 a.m. worship, there will be a Trial Sermon by the candidate recommended by the Search Committee and Council. A congregational meeting and vote will follow worship, so we want you there!

For months now, the Search Committee has been receiving profiles and doing interviews of candidates desiring to be your next called Pastor. One candidate has risen to the top of the list and has been asked to preach at Friedens. Consider it like test driving a car. There is a whole lot more you need to know about the decision, but at least you get an important glimpse of how this might work – what it might look like. At the meeting following worship, the Search Committee will explain key aspects of why THIS candidate might be a good fit. You are encouraged to ask lots of questions! When you are satisfied that you have enough information to make a good decision, there will be a vote on whether or not to call this candidate as your next Pastor.

If the vote is negative, the Search Committee will go back to the search process. There are other good candidates that could be asked to come and present a Trial Sermon, just as in this case. If the vote is positive, a call will be extended to the candidate to be the Pastor of Friedens, and steps will begin to make that happen. That process usually takes around three months. So, in this case, your candidate could begin work here around the first of the year.

This is an exciting time for Friedens! I hope you will share in the excitement, the decision making, and the joy of being the church together!
