Sometimes I wonder if our congregation gets tired of me talking about Lent so much, especially when it comes to fasting and things to give up during the 40 day season. I apologize if it seems like I make too big a deal out of this time between Ash Wednesday and Good Friday but it is very special to me. Perhaps I should tell you why...

27 years ago I was a young father who had just returned to church after 20 year hiatus. I had actually joined for my kid's benefit so that they would be raised up in church. I spent most of my time there trying to dodge attending anything beyond the worship service. But then someone grabbed me asking me to participate in something called a Maundy Thursday "passion play."

I tried to get out of it but they were insistent that I was the only one that could play the part – the part of Jesus. It turns out that most of the members were in their 60s and 70s leaving no one to portray Jesus who was exactly my age when he died. Very reluctantly I began the rehearsals with the rest of the cast (the 12 disciples) during Lent in 1992.


During the course of learning our lines and being dressed in biblical-period garb something began to happen to each of us. Saying the words Jesus and his disciples spoke, dressed in clothes like theirs, sitting at the table together and sharing that final scene, that last time that they were all together, had a profound impact on us. Suddenly, we felt what it must have been like to actually be there and we were forever changed by the experience.

I have had a lot of holy moments in 8 years in ministry but I don't think anything has affected me so profoundly as walking in Jesus' shoes for one night. So, if your pastor keeps making Lent sound like a big deal, he can't help it – it changed his life. May this special season bring changes to your life, as well.

Heart of Texas Association News

We are trying something new at our spring Association Meeting -- offering the option for people to attend by Zoom, a video and audio conference website similar to Skype but with the capacity for several people to participate. The meeting will be at St. Paul UCC in Corpus Christi on Saturday, May 4, at 11 am (10:30 registration for those attending in person). We are preparing for the possibility of having an Ecclesiastical Council for an ordination candidate, meaning that it is very important for us to have a quorum (attendance from a majority of our churches) at the meeting in person or electronically. Of course, we encourage people to be there in person and also to plan to enjoy some time in the Corpus Christi area (on a great weekend to be on the beach). However, we also recognize that the distance will be a problem for some. Anticipating this situation, we intentionally set up our Association bylaws to allow electronic attendance. We will be working over the next few weeks to set up a meeting that will use Zoom, and are planning to send out a letter with instructions in early April. We also anticipate scheduling a couple of times when people can try a trial login to Zoom to connect with our meeting website to be sure it works for those who will be using it. We will need churches who will be having people attend by Zoom to let us know and to try the login in advance. Let's work together to help this happen! It will be a big and good step for our Association that can enable us to continue to have good participation with our long distances.

Our friends at United Christian in Austin have called an interim Senior Minister, Rev. Dr. Laura Barnes, who will be beginning her ministry on May 1. Laura served churches in Danville, California and in San Mateo, California before moving back to her hometown in Dallas, where she has served more recently in interim ministry. United has had a thorough and intentional search process for their interim, with their excellent staff and gifted group of members who serve elsewhere in ministry leading the church during the search. Many of us, myself included, were delighted to meet Laura at the Clergy Retreat in February. We join United in welcoming her to the Heart of Texas Association.

Our South Central Conference Annual Meeting this year will be in New Orleans, always a treat to visit, on Friday May 31- Saturday June 1st. The SCC gathering will be at the Jung Hotel, near downtown and the French Quarter. The theme is "Resurrection Insurrection" with Ron Buford as the guest speaker. Ron currently serves as pastor of the Congregational Church of Sunnyvale, California and was the leader of the God is Still Speaking campaign in the UCC. He gave our ministers a real gift as our Clergy Retreat leader and speaker, with his gracious, articulate, and engaging presence. I hope many of you will go to New Orleans to hear him, to join in fellowship and worship, and to enjoy!
