## Message from the Pastor

In last month's church newsletter I told you about meeting with area clergy and church leaders in Washington at Mt. Zion Porter AME Church on FM 2726 to plan the National Day of Prayer observation on May 2nd. That event was well attended (over 50 people) when it occurred and was an overwhelming success. It also established a precedent – there had never before been an observation like that in Washington. There was another precedent established as well – the Washington-area churches had never come together for a common event like that before, either.

Before I go any further listing precedents I need to stop just a minute to do some bragging; our UCC Women of Friedens Church fed those 50+ participants of the National Day of Prayer event lunch that day. Their hospitality was a big part of what made that event such a success. I'm fairly certain that the love that was shown by our folks on May 2nd had a big impact on the members of the community that turned out for this annual observation.

How we as members of the Christian church demonstrate the love of Jesus Christ out in our community can have a huge impact on the lives of others. It can break down denominational barriers between churches and racial barriers separating groups of people. Together, we can also reach out to the lost (unchurched) in our community with the Gospel as well as lift them up in prayer.

We will be doing just that in a prayer service on Friday, June 28th at 6:00 pm. The place for the event has not yet been determined but the location will be circulated when it is. I hope that you will plan to attend and also be in prayer that God's will be lived out here, in Washington.


#### **Loss of Loved Ones**
