Welcome by Vice Moderator Pastor Car Schwartz-King, (Moderator Linda Coats had a stroke in March and is in a rehab in Humble)

Worship: Touchstone: Kerry Kirtley (from Denver, Co) and Faith NB Carla Cheatham: "Message of Hope"

Inclusive Lord's Prayer (not The Lord's Prayer) 1999 J Manny Sartiego, Reaffirming Baptist

Song: (2018) Brian Sirchio "We Hope" 2 Corinthians 1 3;4, "I Believe" coral video by Mark Miller, Chancel Choir, Christ Church zoom members

Fall meeting had 41 attendees. Fall meeting Minutes were approved.

Treasury report was available in the HoTA website. 2020 Membership dues were down almost 30%.

There was \$5,000 given to Slumber Falls from the Youth fund as the 2020 National Youth Event was virtual. Spending in general has been minimal. Scholarships totaling \$1,500 to Members in discernment from Association funds in 2020 & planned for 2021. Also The Greg Felder funds awarded \$1,500 in 2020 and are planned for 2021. No spending plan prepared for fall 2020 so the 2021 proposal is based on return to commitment by members to contributions. If they do not return in 2021, changes will have to be made. (Copies attached)

SSC: June 12, 2021 Zoom North Assn. is host.

General Synod: Zoom: July 11-18, 2021 open to all to sign in.

Settled Conference Minister will take over at Synod July 11, 2021 date, a Methodist, pastor kid. Thanked Intern Conf Minister Campbell Lovett.

Committee on Ministry: Ann Wherly, Lyons Evangelical Church terminated relationship with United Church of Christ, will affiliate with Evangelical Association of Reformed and Congregational Churches. A nice note was sent from COM wishing them well and an open invite to come back. No change in committee members for 2021 due to being zoom meetings. (Copy attached) Rev Jacquelin Moncrief transfer to Potomac Association, Central Atlantic Conference. Re Licensed Risa Garza, Faith UCC to serve with Rev Eric Gates, Risa is also approved as a member in Discernment.

Unified Fitness Review Process: Rev Charles Stark reported on how this will be uniform in the Conference and not be just the COM of that Association. Will vote on at Fall Meeting

Ecclesiastical Council: Rev Amelia Fulbright (bio attached) Born in Zambia, Africa. Parents Southern Baptist Missionaries in early 1970's. While her dad was in Western North Carolina, she began to have questions about identity where black and white families lived functionally segregated lives. Graduate of Wake Forest and found Southern Baptist denomination a decidedly hostile place for women called to ordained ministry and even worse for the LGBTQIA+ community. She and husband moved to Austin in 2004, transferred into the MDiv program at Austin Presbyterian Theological Seminary and joined the First Baptist Austin. Is a founding member for Labyrinth Progressive Student Ministry, 501 (c) 3, to reach out to students not served by other Christian campus ministry at UT, may are LGBTQIA+. Married 2013. Is inspired by national UCC leaders; Traci Blackmon and Sarah Lund. Primary reasons to draw to the UCC: A Radical hospitality/incisiveness that is always moving to include those on the margins. Is entering the middle of her career and has come up against the Baptist life.

Association Minister Report: Liz Nash-Boerne Touchstone to open on Pentecost with ordination of Rev Kerry Kirtly. Hope United has intern to replace Ron Trimmer. Retire: Scott Martin, New Braunfels Faith, Tom Vanderstadt, 20 year at Austin, Nikkie Stall Resigned from Austin Church, Don Deleon is on Sabbatical. Conference E Newsletter: notice webinar for Hybrid Worship services are mostly on uTube.

Interim Conference Minister: Campbell Lovett: will serve till General Synod Jul 11 with new Conference Minister to officially take over. There is a virtual invite to Synod to register and attend virtually.

Ecclesiastical Council for Rev Dr. Sis Hall (copy attached) of Trinity United Methodist Church, Austin, born in Indiana, Eagle Scout. Going to retire after 40 years in ministry. Worked in the Methodist to accept LBTGQ community to make changes to be accepted, so decided to be dually aligned with the USS to meet that goal. In UCC he can do same sex marriage that the United Methodist does not agree with. He is a 'straight, white, male". The UCC celebrates gay clergy and is immersed in the Holocaust studies. He sacrificed by staying in the Methodist to stand up for acceptance.

Slumber Falls: Jeremy Albers. Ice storm damage repairs are ongoing, had 53 breaks, the need volunteers, they have staff in place. Currently 117 are registered, lots are non UCC members.

There was \$45,000 raised for Covid of the \$200,000 goal. There has been a LBGTQ scholarship + SFC scholarships available. Churches are encourage to sponsor 'Adopt a Cabin" at 50%. There is a new phone system and internet with \$4,000 St John Burton donation for updates. This will provide the chance for volunteers to work virtual but they do need dishwashers.

I did give our 1 minute church report: Fisherman of Friedens work in 3 counties: Washington, Grimes and Burleson with the local food banks, The Chili and Stew Supper is a 70+ year tradition was a drive thru and sold out to the community in 30 minutes. Quilters donate quilts locally. We did the Living Last Supper in person and on FB with great attendance.
